NIGHTLY CLOSURE OF S.R. 606/OSLO ROAD FROM 66TH AVENUE SW TO 58TH AVENUE SW, MAY 14-21, 2026

To enhance safety and long-term resiliency, S.R. 606/Oslo Road between 66th Avenue SW and 58th Avenue SW will be closed nightly, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Thursday, May 14 through Thursday, May 21, 2026, excluding Friday and Saturday nights, for milling and resurfacing work. Tuesday, May 26 through Thursday, May 28, 2026, will be used as contingency nights if needed. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- Westbound S.R. 606/Oslo Road motorists will be detoured via northbound 58th Avenue SW, westbound 1st Street SW and southbound 66th Avenue SW to S.R. 606/Oslo Road.
- Eastbound S.R. 606/Oslo Road motorists will be detoured via northbound 66th Avenue SW, eastbound 1st Street SW and southbound 58th Avenue SW to S.R. 606/Oslo Road.
