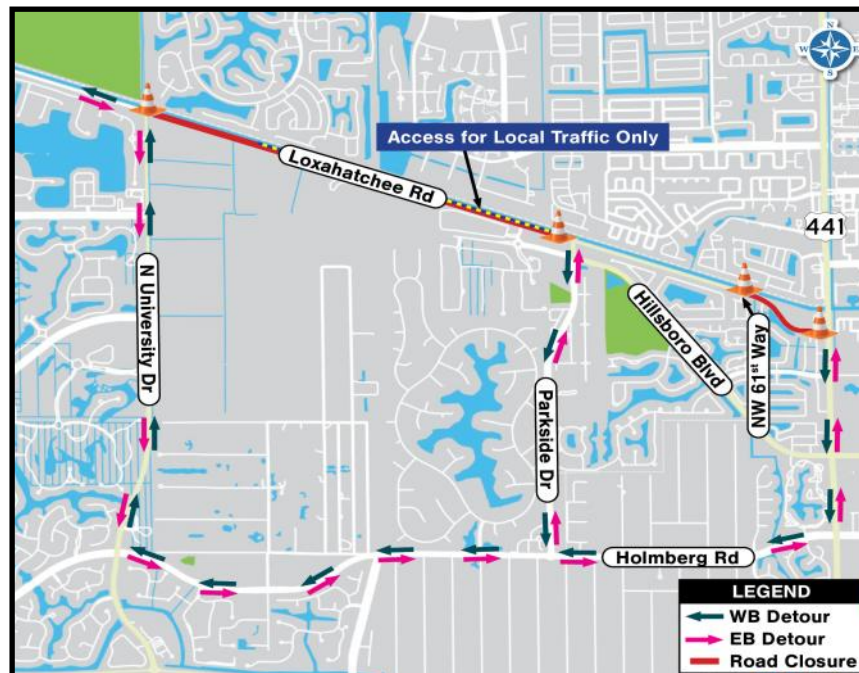

LOXAHATCHEE ROAD WILL BE CLOSED BEGINNING MONDAY, JULY 6 THROUGH SUNDAY, AUG. 9, 2026

To ensure community and crew safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, Loxahatchee Road from N. University Drive to Parkside Drive will be closed to traffic beginning Monday, July 6 through Sunday, Aug. 9, 2026, to install curbs for the median. Access for local traffic will be maintained at all times.

In addition, just east of NW 61st Way to S.R. 7/U.S. 441 will continue to be closed to traffic through Fall 2026.

Traffic will be detoured via N. University Drive, Holmberg Road, and Parkside Drive or S.R. 7/U.S. 441. Properties west of NW 61st Way will continue to be accessed via Parkside Drive. Local access to businesses and residential properties along Loxahatchee Road will be maintained at all times throughout construction.

Construction Start Date: October 30, 2023

Anticipated Completion: Early 2027

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

The project improvements consist of widening the road to accommodate bike lanes, creating a continuous sidewalk on the south side of the road, constructing roundabouts at Nob Hill Road, N. University Drive, and Parkside Drive, adding an additional eastbound left turn lane onto S.R. 7/U.S. 441, milling and resurfacing the roadway, and upgrading signage and pavement markings.
