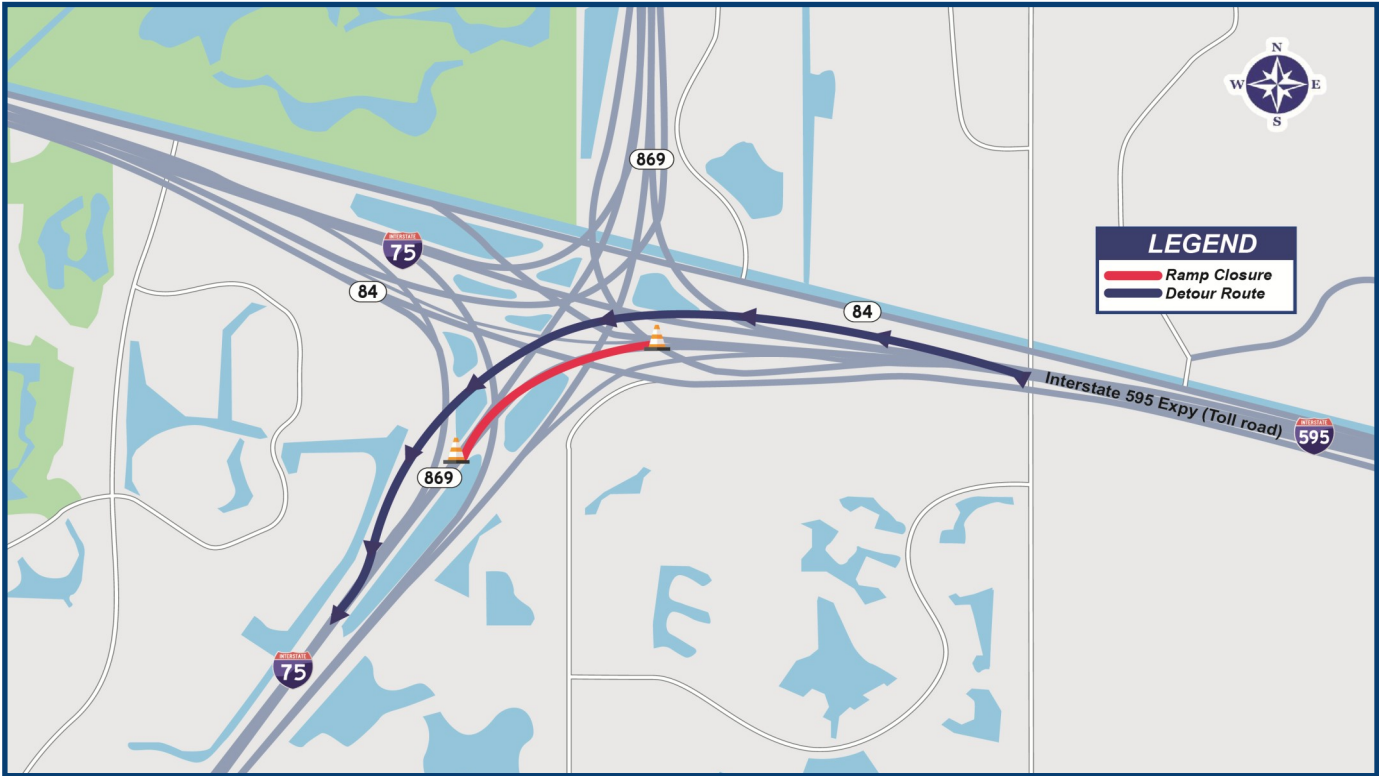
**RAMP FROM WESTBOUND S.R. 862/I-595 EXPRESS LANES TO SOUTHBOUND S.R. 93/I-75 EXPRESS LANES TO CLOSE
SEPTEMBER 21 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 25**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close the entrance ramp from westbound S.R. 862/I-595 Express Lanes to the southbound S.R. 93/I-75 Express Lanes, as well as the southbound S.R. 93/I-75 Express Lanes ingress point at Royal Palm Boulevard, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, September 21 through Friday, September 25, for underground lighting and drill shaft operations.

During this closure, motorists will be detoured via S.R. 862/I-595 to the S.R. 93/I-75 southbound General Purpose Lanes and will be able to re-enter the southbound S.R. 93/I-75 Express Lanes at the S.R. 822/Sheridan Street entrance.

Monday, September 28 through Friday, October 2, will be used as contingency dates if needed. Detour signs will be in place and the Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite to assist motorists.
