S.R. 9/I-95 RAMPS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the upcoming S.R. 9/I-95 Ramps Improvements Project at S.R. 704/Okeechobee Boulevard, S.R. 786/ PGA Boulevard, and S.R. 706/Indiantown Road in Palm Beach County. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

Construction Cost: \$1.2 Million

Construction Start: January 2026

Estimated Completion: Summer 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installing high friction surface treatment on all ramps to enhance infrastructure resilience and improve vehicle safety.
- Upgrading to new LED lighting and replacing the existing guardrail for the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 on-ramp from eastbound S.R. 704/Okeechobee Boulevard to enhance vehicle safety.
- Installing a digital speed feedback sign on the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 off-ramp to westbound S.R. 786/ PGA Boulevard.
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings to enhance visibility and safety.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public.
- Full ramp closures are permitted from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning.
 - Consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.
 - Ramp detours will be clearly signed when closures are in place.
- Sidewalk and curb ramp closures will be implemented as needed with temporary pedestrian detours.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.

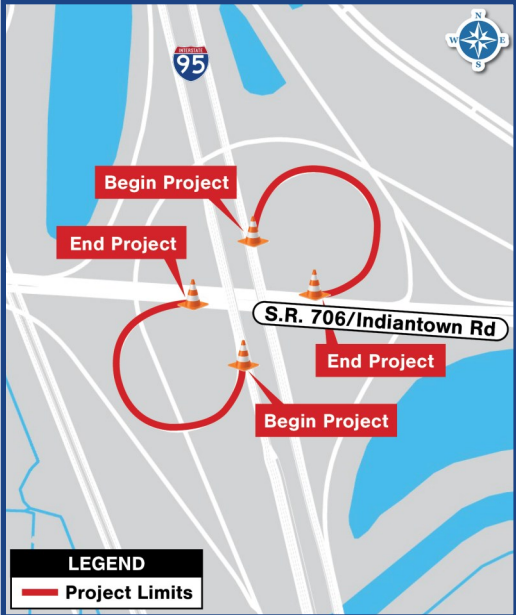
