## NW 7TH STREET AND EASTBOUND BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD INTERSECTION CLOSURE THROUGH EARLY SUMMER 2026 FOR DRAINAGE INSTALLATION

Beginning Monday, May 18, the NW 7th Street and eastbound Boynton Beach Boulevard intersection will be closed to traffic through early summer 2026 to install drainage under the roadway. A lane reduction and traffic shift is currently in place in this area on eastbound Boynton Beach Boulevard from NW 8th Street to east of W. Industrial Avenue to perform road and bridge widening on the south side of the project limits through the remainder of this year. Barrier wall has also been installed along the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Boynton Beach Boulevard to create a work zone.

- During the drainage installation at NW 7th Street, motorists may detour via NW 1st Avenue and NW 8th Street to access Boynton Beach Boulevard
- There is currently only one northbound lane of NW 8th Street at Boynton Beach Boulevard for right, left, and through traffic movements; please allow extra travel time
- The signal timing and phasing is also being reviewed for possible adjustments as needed throughout the project corridor



### WORK ZONE SAFETY REMINDERS

- Please proceed with caution through the work zone, drive safely, expect delays, allow additional travel time, and seek alternate routes as needed
