S.R. 9/I-95 Northbound to Eastbound and Westbound S.R. 862/I-595 Ramps

NORTHBOUND S.R. 9/I-95 EXIT RAMP TO S.R. 862/I-595 RAMPS TO CLOSE, NIGHTLY AS NEEDED, MARCH 22-26 AND 30

The northbound S.R. 9/I-95 exit ramp to the S.R. 862/I-595 ramps will be closed to traffic, nightly as needed, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., beginning Sunday, March 22 through Thursday, March 26, and Monday, March 30. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely perform water blasting and temporary striping operations.

- Traffic will be detoured via the S.R. 9/I-95 exit ramp to eastbound S.R. 818/Griffin Road, and northbound U.S. 1/ S.R. 5 to access S.R. 862/I-595. As an alternate detour to access westbound S.R. 862/I-595, traffic may also be routed via the S.R. 84/Marina Mile Boulevard exit ramp and continue on westbound S.R. 84/Marina Mile Boulevard to access westbound S.R. 862/I-595.
- Motorists traveling on northbound S.R. 9/I-95 to access the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport (FLL) must exit at S.R. 818/Griffin Road.
- Motorists wishing to access Port Everglades Seaport (PEV) may continue northbound on S.R. 9/I-95 to the S.R. 84/ Marina Mile Boulevard exit ramp.

Sunday, March 29 and Tuesday, March 31 will be used as contingency nights if needed. The **Florida Highway Patrol (FHP)** will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area.
