State Road (S.R.) 838/Sunrise Boulevard at S.R. 9/I-95 Interchange Improvements and Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project—Full Closure Notice

State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 to S.R. 5/U.S. 1

NORTHBOUND S.R. 9/I-95 AT S.R. 838/SUNRISE BLVD TO CLOSE TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8

All lanes of northbound S.R. 9/I-95 at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 29B) will be closed to traffic, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8. This closure is necessary to safely allow crews to perform the placement of beams.

During the full closure, northbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the exit ramp to eastbound S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 29A), northbound S.R. 845/Powerline Road/NW 9th Avenue, and westbound S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard to access the S.R. 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp.

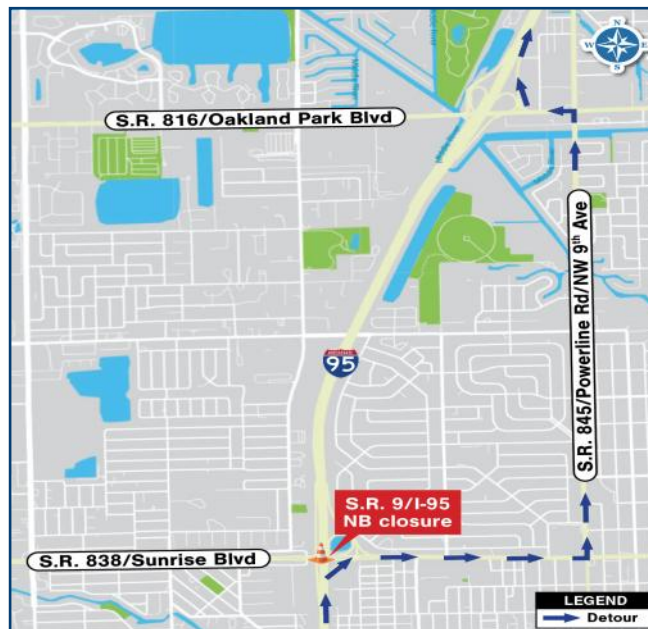
Motorists travelling within the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes will exit at S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to follow the detour. The entrance to the S.R. 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes south of Stirling Road will be closed; the next available entrance is north of Cypress Creek Road.

In association with the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 full closure, the following ingress location to the S.R. 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes will remain closed during this period:

- Direct connect entrance ramp to the S.R. 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes from the eastbound I-595 Express Lanes
- Direct connect entrance ramp to the S.R. 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes from the Broward Boulevard Park & Ride

Wednesday, September 9, will be used as a contingency night if needed. The **Florida Highway Patrol (FHP)** will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area.
