SOUTHBOUND S.R. 9/I-95 AT S.R. 838/SUNRISE BLVD TO CLOSE THURSDAY, AUGUST 20

All lanes of southbound S.R. 9/I-95 at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Thursday, August 20. This closure is necessary to safely allow crews to perform the placement of beams.

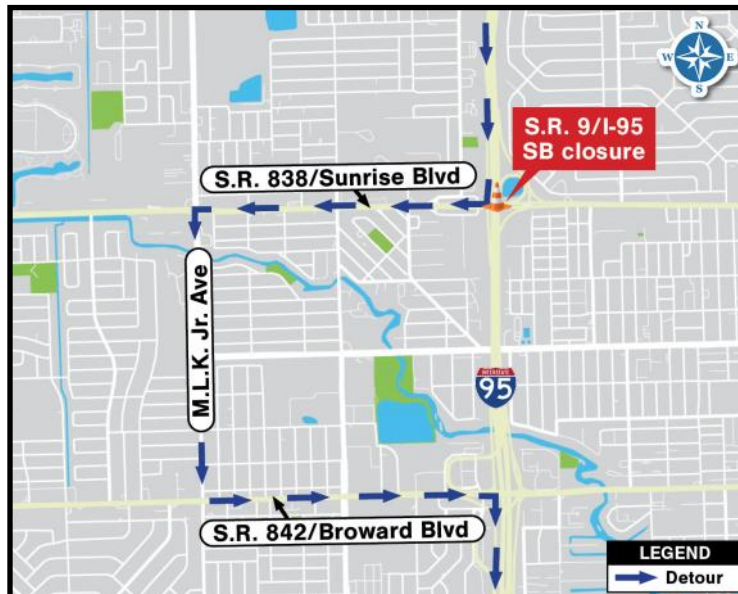
During the full closure, southbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the exit ramp to westbound S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard, southbound Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, and eastbound S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard to access the S.R. 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp.

To ensure motorists and crew safety, the southbound managed lane ingress at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. Motorists may enter the managed lanes at the S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard ingress.

- In association with this closure, the southbound express lane ingress at S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed.

Sunday, August 23, will be used as a contingency night if needed. The **Florida Highway Patrol (FHP)** will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area.
