SOUTHBOUND S.R. 9/I-95 AT S.R. 838/SUNRISE BLVD TO CLOSE NIGHTLY ON SEPT. 9, 14, 16, 21, and 22

All lanes of southbound S.R. 9/I-95 at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed to traffic, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Wednesday night, September 9, Monday night, September 14, and Wednesday night, September 16, Monday night, September 21, and Tuesday night, September 22. This closure is necessary for crews to perform the placement of beams.

During the full closure, southbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the S.R. 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard, westbound S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard, southbound Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, eastbound S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard, and then the S.R. 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Express lane traffic will exit just south of Atlantic Blvd into the general-purpose lanes.

To ensure motorists and crew safety, the southbound express lane ingress north of S.R. 838/Sunrise Blvd will be closed. Signage will be in place to assist motorists. The **Florida Highway Patrol (FHP)** will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area.
