### S.R. 9/I-95 Northbound to S.R. 862/I-595 Ramps Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the S.R. 9/I-95 Northbound to S.R. 862/I-595 Ramps Improvements Project. This project aims to enhance safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

**Construction Cost:** \$5,296,366

**Construction Start:** January 2026

**Estimated Completion:** Early 2027

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term pavement resilience
- Minor widening of the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 ramp to eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 to enhance safety
- Installing Dynamic Curve Warning and Wet Roadway Information Systems at the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 ramp to westbound S.R. 862/I-595 to enhance safety
- Constructing new guardrail along both sides of the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 ramp to eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 to enhance safety
- Installing new light poles with LED fixtures along the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 ramp to westbound S.R. 862/I-595 to improve nighttime visibility and safety
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings throughout the project limits to increase nighttime visibility

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures are permitted nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- A continuous single lane closure is permitted as needed along northbound S.R. 9/I-95 to eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 ramp to facilitate construction operations
- Full ramp closures are permitted nightly as needed, from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving and overhead sign structure operations
- Shoulder closures are permitted as needed for daytime and nighttime work within the project limits
