S.R. A1A/S. COUNTY ROAD FROM BRAZILIAN AVENUE TO S.R. 704/ROYAL PALM WAY SIDEWALK REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT EXPECTED TO BEGIN MONDAY, AUG. 10, 2026

Beginning Monday, August 10, 2026, crews will begin to remove and replace the existing concrete sidewalk and curb along both the east and west sides of S.R. A1A/S. County Road from Brazilian Avenue to S.R. 704/Royal Palm Way. Sidewalk work can be expected through August/Early September 2026.

**Work will be done in phases to minimize impacts,
and access to businesses will be maintained during this time.**

- To expedite operations, the contractor will perform concrete saw cutting and other prep work, daily, 8 a.m. until 6 p.m., Monday, Aug. 3, through Friday, Aug. 7
- It is kindly suggested to remove temporary signage and business items from the sidewalk during prep work and construction activities to avoid dust and debris
- In order to stage equipment and complete construction operations, access to parking spaces will be required at various times
- Lane closures can be expected, daily, 8 a.m. until 6 p.m., and nightly, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday; however, most sidewalk work is expected during the day
- The project team will continue to coordinate with businesses and stakeholders on the construction schedule until completed
