### S.R. A1A/South Ocean Drive Drainage Improvements Project Full Closure to begin Monday, April 20 at 11:59 p.m.

S.R. A1A/South Ocean Drive between S.R. 822/Sheridan Street and Thomas Street will be closed to through traffic, around the clock, for 72 hours, beginning Monday, April 20, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. through Thursday, April 23, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. for roadway construction work. Southbound S.R. A1A/South Ocean Drive will be detoured via S.R. 822/Sheridan Street, U.S. 1/Federal Highway, and S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard. Northbound S.R. A1A/South Ocean Drive will be detoured via S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard, U.S. 1/Federal Highway, and S.R. 822/Sheridan Street. Access will be maintained for local traffic, residents, businesses, and emergency services. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

Construction Cost: \$34.3 Million

Construction Start: July 2025

Estimated Completion: Summer 2028
