SIDEWALK CLOSURE ALONG S.R. 7/U.S. 441 ON MARCH 23, 2026


OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close the northbound (east) sidewalk along S.R. 7/U.S. 441, just south of the S.R. 80/Southern Boulevard Ramps in the Village of Royal Palm Beach, for work under the ramps and the widening of the bridge over the C-51 Canal. The sidewalk closure will be continuous starting on Monday, March 23, 2026, until Summer 2026. Please be advised, this schedule may change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Detour Information:

- Pedestrians and cyclists wishing to utilize the northbound (east) sidewalk along S.R. 7/U.S. 441 will be detoured to the signalized intersection at Erica Boulevard to access the southbound (west) sidewalk along S.R. 7/U.S. 441. From there, continue north past Acme Road, under the Southern Boulevard ramps, and across at the signalized intersection to access the S.R. 7/U.S. 441 sidewalks.

Please note, detours will not overlap with ongoing closures.
