

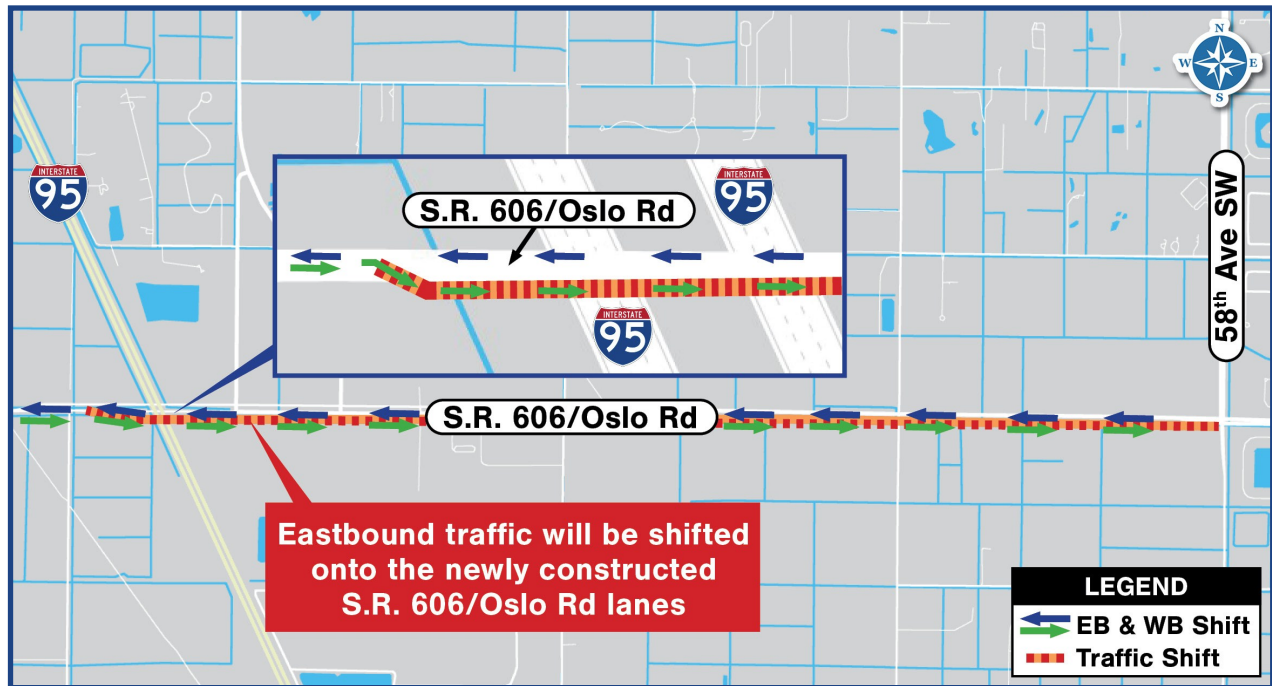

S.R. 606/OSLO ROAD EASTBOUND TRAFFIC TO BE SHIFTED JUNE 28, 2026

As part of the S.R. 9/I-95 at S.R. 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and S.R. 606/Oslo Road Widening Project, crews will implement a traffic shift beginning at 5 p.m. (subject to change), Sunday, June 28, 2026, pending weather. The traffic shift will occur on S.R. 606/Oslo Road from approximately 1,500 feet west of the S.R. 606/Oslo Road bridge over S.R. 9/I-95 to SW 58th Avenue. One westbound lane will remain open on the westbound roadway, and the single eastbound traffic lane currently operating on the westbound roadway will be shifted to one eastbound lane on the eastbound roadway. This shift is necessary to safely perform sidewalk construction activities as well as sod and signage installation. If weather or unforeseen circumstances occur, the shift will begin on Monday, June 29.
