

Project Location and Overview

Project Location and Overview

- Federally Funded Safety Project
- Located in the Cities of Weston, Sunrise and Town of Davie in western Broward County
- Project Limits:
 - SR 93/I-75 from SR 862/I-595 & SR 869/Sawgrass Expressway Interchange to SR 25/US 27
 - MP 11.200 to MP 18.870 (7.67 Miles)
- Design = 70 mph | Posted = 70 mph
- Markham Park and Everglades Management Area located on the north side
- Residential, agricultural, and commercial uses on the south side



Proposed Improvements

- Installation of new lighting along the I-75 mainline between the bridge over Weston Road and east of US 27
- Providing shielding for lighting fixtures west of Bonaventure Boulevard to minimize potential glare to nearby residential developments
- Upgrading the existing lighting at the Glades Parkway Interchange for uniformity of lighting
- Upgrading the existing lighting along the I-75 curve (near the I-595 & Sawgrass Expressway interchange) with Light Emitting Diode (LED) fixtures to improve energy efficiency and enhance light quality and lifespan

Lighting Improvements


Lighting Design Features

- LED lighting fixtures with 3000K Color Temperature (Warm)
- Includes light shields to minimize glare and light trespass beyond the right of way line
- Similar to the existing lighting shield used at the Glades Parkway Interchange

Proposed Lighting West of Glades Pkwy




Existing Lighting Remain at Glades Pkwy Interchange





Legend

- (Green) New Light Poles



Proposed Lighting at Bonaventure Blvd interchange





Construction Impacts

Construction Impacts

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Light poles are located on the roadway shoulders so work will require temporary closure of the roadway shoulder
- Temporary travel lane closures will be required for installation of light poles along bridge approaches
- Construction within the segments adjacent to the residential neighborhoods will be restricted to daytime operations in compliance with the City of Weston noise ordinance



Project Schedule and Cost

Project Schedule and Cost


- Notice to Proceed: December 2023
- Letting: July 2026
- Anticipated Construction Start : Winter 2027
- Anticipated Construction Completion: Winter 2029
- Estimated Construction Cost : \$7 million
