S.R. 9/I-95 RAMP SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the upcoming S.R. 9/I-95 Ramp Safety Improvement Project in St. Lucie County. The project limits are on the S.R. 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to westbound S.R. 68/Orange Avenue. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

Construction Cost: \$840,956

Construction Start: March 2026

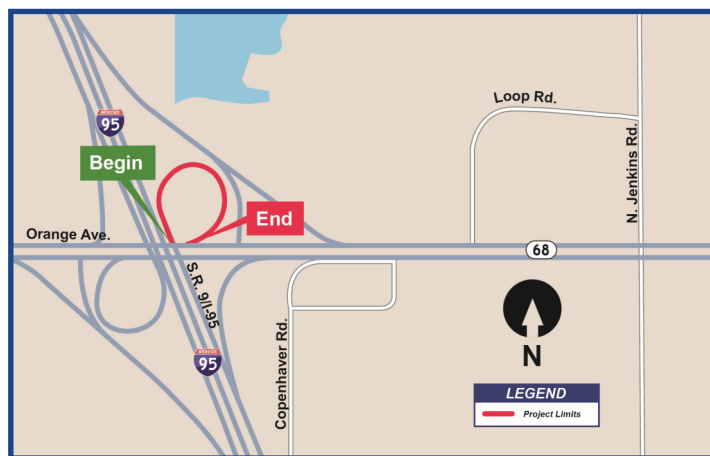
Estimated Completion: Fall 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Resurfacing and restriping the ramp to enhance safety and long-term resiliency.
- Installing a high-friction surface treatment on the ramp to enhance safety.
- Widening the existing left shoulder from two feet to four feet (paved) to improve roadside safety and traffic operations.
- Upgrading lighting on the project, including new technology such as LED light fixtures, to increase nighttime visibility.
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings to enhance safety, functionality, and traffic operations.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Northbound S.R. 9/I-95 to westbound S.R. 68/Orange Avenue ramp closures are permitted nightly, 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- Motorists will be detoured via northbound S.R. 9/I-95 to eastbound S.R. 68/Orange Avenue, to northbound North Jenkins Road, and westbound Loop Road to westbound S.R. 68/Orange Avenue.
