NORTH 22ND AVENUE/SW 12TH AVENUE COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the North 22nd Avenue/SW 12th Avenue Complete Streets Project in the cities of Hollywood and Dania Beach. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

The cities of Hollywood and Dania Beach, as the Project Sponsors, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the North 22nd Avenue/SW 12th Avenue Complete Streets Project in the cities of Hollywood and Dania Beach, Resolution No. 2025-005 & No. 2024-143. Construction Cost: \$2,926,111

Construction Start: February 2026

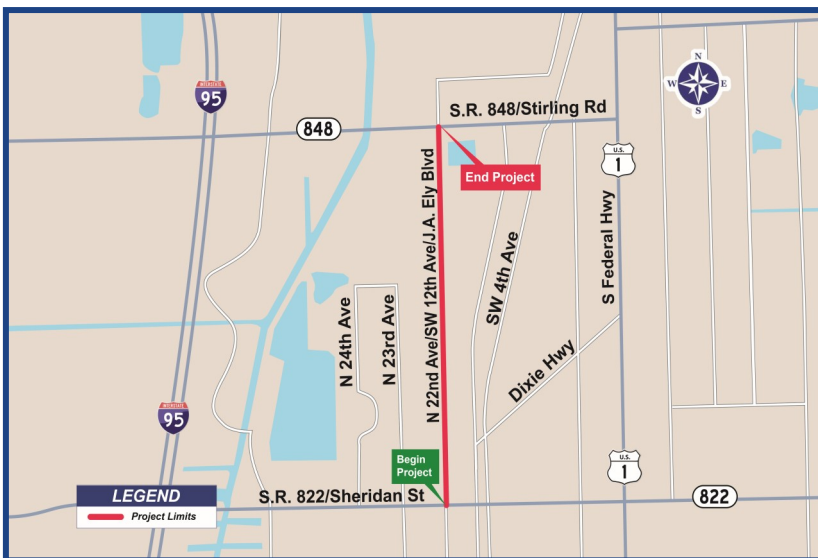
Estimated Completion: Early 2027

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway to ensure long term resiliency.
- Installing speed tables at strategic locations to reduce speeds and improve pedestrian safety.
- Installing three raised intersections at SW 10th Street, SW 8th Street and SW 7th Street to enhance visibility and multi-modal safety.
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings including shared lane markings (sharrows).
- Upgrading concrete sidewalks and curb ramps to improve accessibility and pedestrian safety.
- Installing new light poles with LED fixtures throughout the project corridor to enhance nighttime visibility and safety.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures when needed, as follows:
 - 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday
 - 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday
- Side street detours will be required to complete the raised intersections at SW 10th Street, SW 8th Street, and SW 7th Street.
