PROJECT PURPOSE: To make improvements throughout the intersection which will improve safety for all users of the intersection.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Implement Flashing Yellow Arrows (FYA) for the northbound and southbound left turns.
- Relocate pedestrian push buttons closer to the crosswalks at the northwest and northeast corners.
- Implement leading pedestrian intervals (LPI) for all crosswalks.
- Replace existing pedestrian signals with new Accessible Pedestrian Signals (APSs).



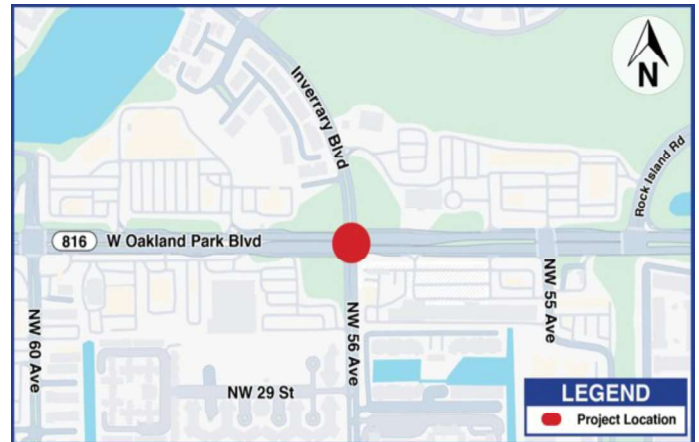

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Temporary lane closures and traffic shifts during construction.
- Temporary sidewalk and crosswalk closures, with pedestrian detours provided as needed.
- Temporary noise and dust associated with construction activities.
- Access to adjacent businesses and properties will be maintained throughout construction.

CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- Anticipated Construction Start: October 2027
- Anticipated Completion End: January 2028
- Estimated Construction Cost: \$550,000
