The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will conduct a public meeting for the above referenced project within Broward County. This public meeting will be offered in-person and virtually simultaneously. The public meeting will have representatives available to answer questions. Project information will be available for public viewing. Questions and comments may be submitted prior to the meeting by contacting the Project Manager Haiyan Ou, P.E. PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Extend the pavement life and improve safety by removing the existing asphalt and replacing it with new pavement of the same type.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway to ensure a smooth, safe, and resilient drive.
- Crews will upgrade signalization, sidewalk, and curb ramps to meet current standards.
- Replacing and upgrading signs and pavement markings to meet current standards and increase reflectivity.
- Installing pedestrian signal upgrades to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community.
- Phase I: Work within the outside lanes, driveways, sidewalks, and pedestrian ramps. Constructing signal and lighting improvements.
- Phase II: Work within the median.
- Phase III: Milling and resurfacing, signing and pavement marking.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained during construction.
- Temporary impacts to pedestrian traffic will be addressed by pedestrian detours and/or diversions

CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- Anticipated Construction Start: **Fall 2027**
- Anticipated Construction End: **Fall 2029**
- Estimated Construction Cost: **\$7.1 Million**

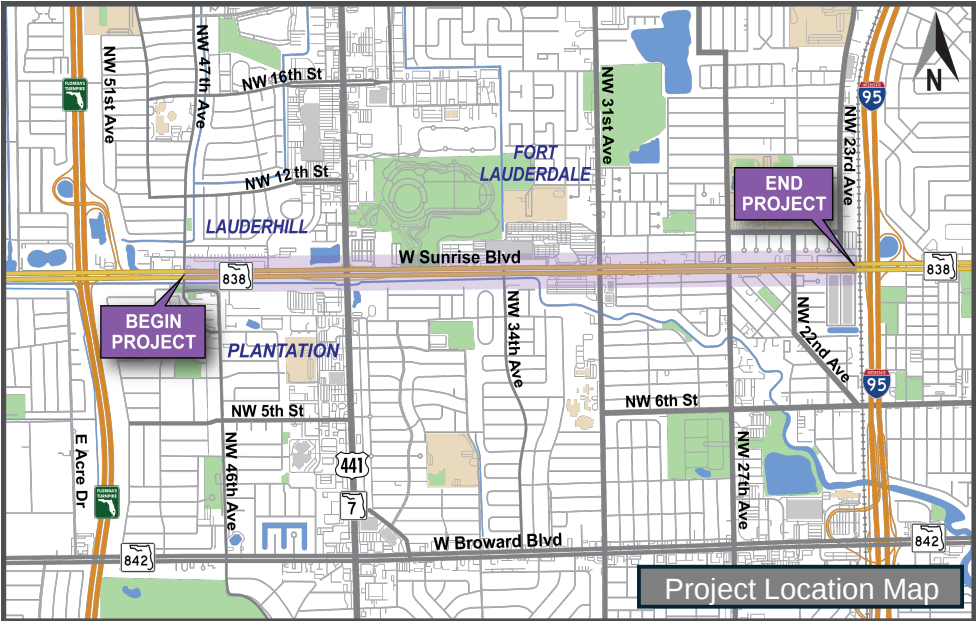
